Deadline: December 3, 2007

Please include all of the following information in your proposal:

1. Name,
Job Title,
e-mail address,
phone number for each presenter (include home and office phone numbers, if applicable)
2. Presentation Title
3. An abstract of the presentation content (600 words or less)
4. An indication of the conference content area(s) into which your topic would most likely fall (database administration, security, database development, operating systems/hardware, panel discussion, etc.)
5. A brief session description for publication in conference agenda (one 75-word paragraph)
6. Presenter(s) bio(s) suitable for publication
7. Any further information that might be helpful in determining the relevance of your topic to the conference
